Mayor Melani Torgersen called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Escalante City Council Chambers.

ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

Council member Stowe moved to adopt the agenda as written. Council member Porter seconded the motion. Motion carried with Council members Stowe, Wilson, Orme and Porter voting aye.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 5, 2024 MEETING

Council member Wilson moved to approve the minutes of the November 5, 2024 meeting as written. Council member Orme seconded the motion. Motion carried with Council members Wilson, Orme, Stowe and Porter voting aye.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments at this time.

PLANNING AND ZONING ITEMS PLANNING AND ZONING UPDATES

City Recorder Steed explained Planning and Zoning has completed the Subdivision updates with the Hansen Group and will have the public hearing on November 26 for input from the public.

TROY AND LISA CRUMP – RESIDENTIAL HOME AND ACCESSORY BUILDING WITH BATHROOM – 599 MOQUI LANE - RR-1-20

City Recorder Steed explained this project. City Recorder Steed said Planning and Zoning recommended the small residential home presented and the accessory building without the showers to the City Council for approval. City Recorder Steed said Mr. and Mrs. Crump were denied the RV pads and the showers in the accessory building and they have revised their plans to comply with the approval. Council member Wilson moved to approve the one residential home and accessory building with bathrooms as presented and no RV pads for Mr. and Mrs. Crump. Council member Stowe seconded the motion. Motion carried with Council members Orme, Stowe, Porter and Wilson voting aye.

SCHEDULED ITEMS

TROY AND LISA CRUMP NEW WATER CONNECTION - 599 MOQUI LANE

Council member Wilson asked what the size of the waterline is on Moqui Lane. Council member Porter said the water connection will have to come from Old Main and it is an eight-inch line. Council member Orme said the letter attached states the Crump's will get an easement from Reed Munson for the utility lines. Council member Porter explained the water meter will be on the City Right-of-Way. Council member Wilson asked if there is something in the ordinance about waterlines going from one property to another. Council member Porter said the City is only liable to put in the meter and it will be on the City Right-of-Way so the Crumps will have to get the easements to run their waterline from the meter. Council member Porter moved to approve the new water connection for Mr. and Mrs. Crump. Council member Orme seconded the motion. Motion carried with Council members Stowe, Porter, Orme and Wilson voting aye.

TROY AND LISA CRUMP NEW SEWER CONNECTION - 599 MOQUI LANE

Council member Porter said the sewer can be connected from Old Main. Council member Porter explained the City is only liable for the main line and the Crumps will have to get easements to run the sewer to their property. Council member Orme said in the letter attached to the application it states Reed Munson will be installing all the utilities and giving an easement to the Crumps. Council member Orme moved to approve the new sewer connection for Mr. and Mrs. Crump. Council member Porter seconded the motion. Motion carried with Council members Wilson, Porter, Orme and Stowe voting aye.

CHRISTMAS BONUS

Mayor Torgersen said in the past the City has given cheese to the first responders, volunteers, employees and Council members. Mayor Torgersen explained the City has also given a bonus to the employees and Council members. Council member Wilson moved to approve the cheese and bonuses as done in the past. FIRE DEPARTMENT

BILL WEPPNER

Mr. Weppner explained the Fire Department is in the third year of changing over the State required radios and they are still having issues. Mr. Weppner explained that with the new radios it has caused problems with the paging system and not all the fire fighters are receiving the pages.

Mr. Weppner said since the last meeting there have been two incidents. Mr. Weppner explained there was a brush fire and a UTV recovery of a young man on the Big Horn Trail on the Monument. Mr. Weppner said Fred Spencer took the UTV out for the recovery and did an
